

Purchasing Policy

Bondalti¹ is aware of the importance of sustainability for the development of its activity. Accordingly, it meets its ethical, social and environmental concerns by adopting the best international practices in this field.

Bondalti has signed up to the Responsible Care® principles of CEFIC (The European Chemical Industry Council) and the Charter of Principles of BCSD Portugal (Corporate Council for Sustainable Development), which advocate good sustainable purchasing practices.

This Purchasing Policy establishes Bondalti's action principles:

1. Compliance with the law and regulation in force and the relevant internal governance procedures;
2. Adoption of Bondalti's Code of Ethics, which is made available to Suppliers, thereby undertaking to refrain from any illegal or fraudulent practices and promoting a practice of transparency and respect for Human Rights;
3. Access provided to Suppliers to the General Conditions of Purchase for the supply of products and/or services;
4. Access provided to Suppliers to the internal safety rules in force at any time;
5. Definition of purchase requirements in line with the best practices, to promote social and environmental responsibility and the Circular Economy;
6. Promotion of continuous improvement and innovation for the development of new market solutions/opportunities that are more sustainable;
7. Promotion of the social and economic development of its neighbouring Local Community;
8. Performance of Suppliers Evaluation in accordance with the criticality of the supply, and disclosure of respective criteria;
9. Analysis and classification of Suppliers, favouring in the selection process those committed to Ethics, Social Responsibility and Environmental Sustainability principles.
10. Access to appropriate consultation and communication channels.

Bondalti undertakes to ensure the adequate means and structures to promote the implementation and fulfilment of this Policy.
